Introduction:

A. Theme scripture, bookmark: 1 Corinthians 9:24.

1. Distribute.

2. Discuss.

A. Warm-up: Blab school.

1. Team up in twos.

C. Begin the Speeches

D. Evaluate, reinforce, compliment after each speaker.

1. Hand out voting cards.
